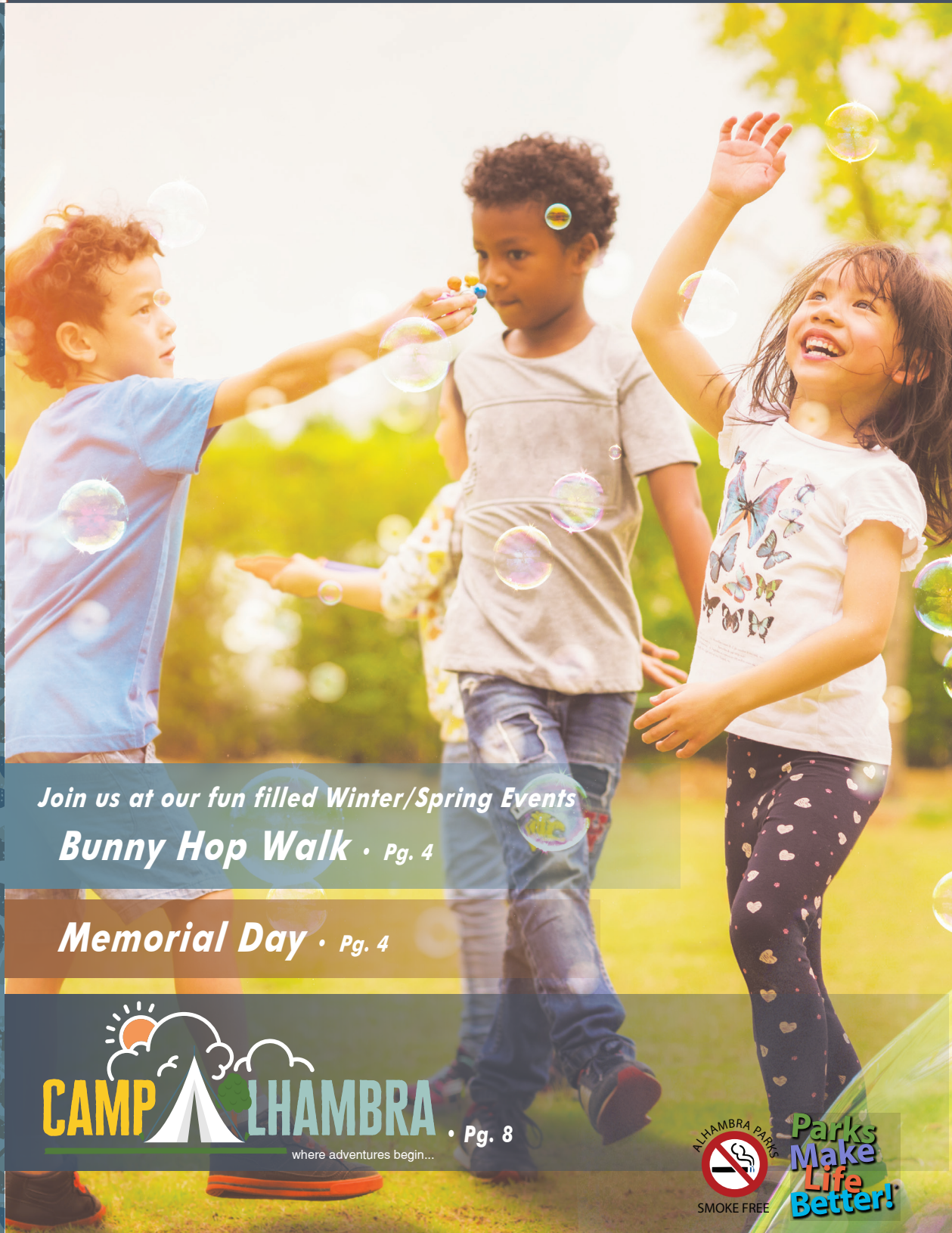

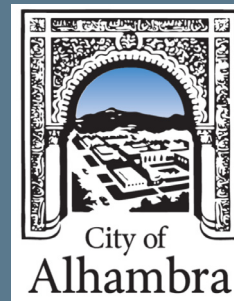

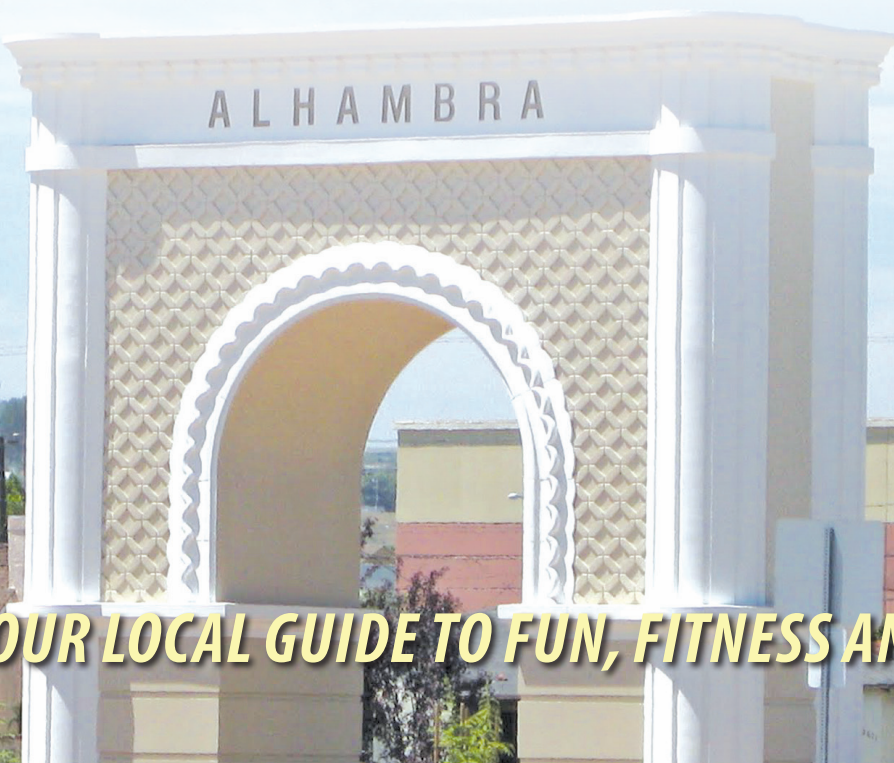

E-WASTE & BULK ITEMS DISPOSAL

Electronic waste, such as computers, televisions, stereos and printers, and bulk items, such as mattresses and furniture, require separate disposal from your black, green or blue bin. Please don't dump items on someone else's property – that's illegal dumping. And don't set these items at your own curb, hoping they'll be picked up – that's not neighborly. Contact Republic Services at (800) 299-4898 or Alhambra@republicservices.com to schedule a bulk item or E-waste pickup. Each single-family residential customer is entitled to receive four bulk item pickups per year. Up to four bulk and/or electronic items or up to 10 bags of clean yard waste (no trash) will be accepted per pickup. Additional pickups are available year-round for a fee.

Please note that placing items on the curb without scheduling a pickup is considered illegal dumping and you may be cited by the City. For more information, visit <https://www.cityofalhabra.org/302/Bulky-Item-Pick-Up>.

- **Retailer Take Back:** By California Law, when you purchase a mattress from a retailer, they are required to offer to pick up your old mattress, at no cost, when they drop your new one.
- **Recycle your Mattress:** In addition to contacting Republic Services, you can visit byebyemattress.com to find a recycler near you.



DOS AND DON'TS OF ORGANICS RECYCLING

Acceptable Materials for Green Organics Cart or Dumpster:

- Yard trimmings • Flower trimmings
- Food-soiled paper (napkins and paper towels, uncoated paper: plates, cups, bowls & pizza boxes)
- Tree trimmings (twigs/branches must be 4 ft or less in length, and less than 6 inches in diameter)
- Leaves, grass, brush and weeds
- Untreated and unpainted wood
- Food scraps (raw or cooked):
 - Fruits • Vegetables • Dairy products • Breads • Grains • Pastas
 - Meat and seafood (including bones)
 - Prepared or processed foods (chips, sandwiches, etc – remove packaging)
- Plastic bags
 - Note that all other plastics are NOT allowed

Unacceptable Materials for Green Organics Cart or Dumpster:

- Dog poop or pet waste from any animal • Diapers
- Glass • Metal • Plastic • Hot ashes or briquettes
- Large amounts of soil or sod
- Plastics aside from plastic bags
- Rocks • Concrete • Dirt • Sand • Styrofoam • Particle board
- Wood that has been treated, coated or painted
- Compostable plastics, including bags and utensils

DOS AND DON'TS OF RECYCLING

Acceptable Materials for Blue Recycling Cart or Dumpster:

- Paper & Cardboard:
 - Cardboard (flattened) • Office paper & file folders • Junk Mail
 - Magazines, newspapers, catalogs & telephone books
- Plastics:
 - Plastic bottles and containers (such as soda/water bottles, milk jugs, shampoo and conditioner bottles, yogurt containers, and margarine containers)
- Aluminum/Metal:
 - Aluminum, tin or steel cans • Foil • Pie tins
- Glass:
 - Glass bottles and jars

Unacceptable Materials for Blue Recycling Cart or Dumpster:

- Plastic grocery bags
- Light bulbs, window glass, or mirrors
- Ceramics or dishes • Clothing • Toys
- Polystyrene foam (Styrofoam)
- Garden hoses • Oil containers of any kind
- Soiled or wet paper • Coffee cups

LET'S DO OUR PART TO CONSERVE WATER

The San Gabriel Valley continues to be in a severe drought. Alhambra residents can take action by reducing their water consumption. Below is a partial list of the current City of Alhambra's Stage 2 Water Conservation Restrictions. Please visit our website <https://www.cityofalhabra.org/615/Drought-Updates> for more information.

- Outdoor irrigation is restricted to two days a week.
- No outdoor irrigation between 10:00 AM and 5:00 PM.
- No outdoor irrigation within 48 hours after measurable rain.
- No outdoor irrigation that results in run-off from the property.
- No washing down sidewalks, driveways or any paved surfaced.
- All leaks must be repaired as soon as reasonably possible.
- Car washing is restricted to commercial car wash or with hose with shutoff nozzle.

Water Savings Tips for Homes and Businesses

- Install water efficient showerheads, toilets, and faucet aerators.
- Regularly check and repair water leaks around the home and business.
- Use a broom instead of a hose to clean patios, driveways, and sidewalks.
- Water lawns and gardens in cooler morning or evening hours.
- Support efforts to expand water conservation and storm water capture.
- Landscape with CA native plants or drought tolerant plants.
- Increase engagement with water conservation awareness and rebate programs.

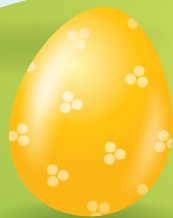

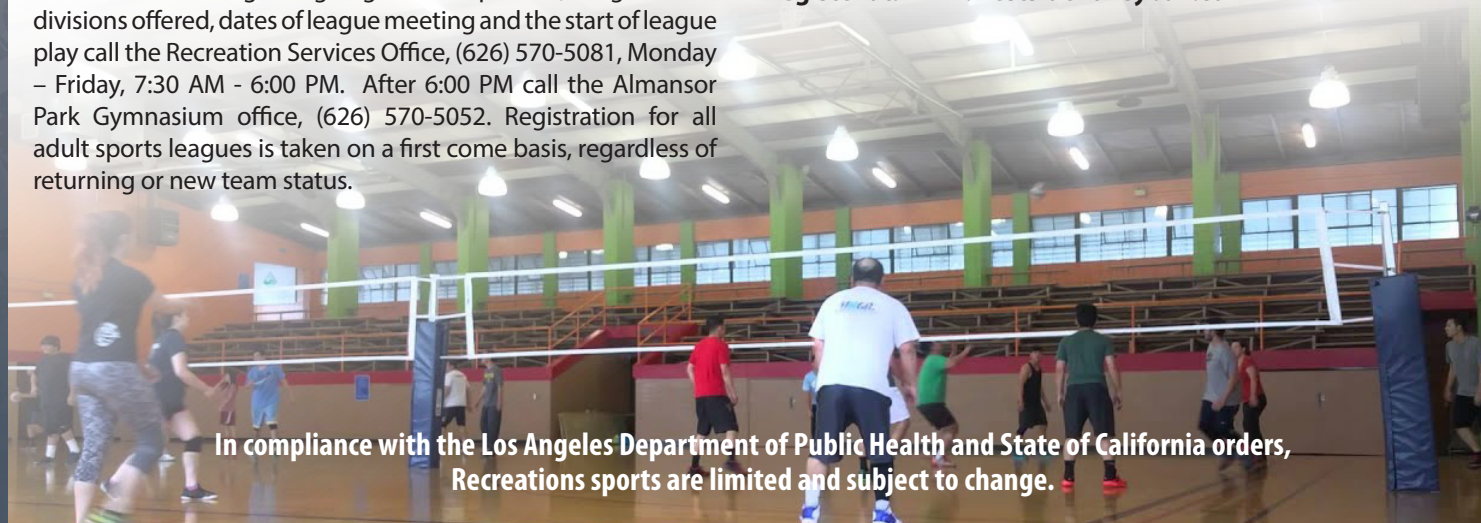

SWIMMING LESSONS

Youth and Adult lessons will consist of a 40 minute class on Saturday & Sunday for four weeks; and a 30 minute class on Tuesday & Thursday for 3 weeks. A skill's test will be given, when needed, at the beginning of each session, to determine the appropriate level of instruction. Please note that the following are general age and class descriptions intended to help you register for the appropriate class. Classes require a minimum enrollment to be conducted. Registration is accepted online – Cityofalhambra.org.

Parent/Child - This class is designed to introduce parents & children to the aquatic environment. Parents will be instructed on how to teach water adjustment skills to their children. Ages: 6 months to 3 years.

MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS

Always have priority. On occasion, you may be asked to re-schedule your social or shopping appointment because someone has an emergency medical appointment. We will do the same for you, should you have a medical emergency.

Senior Ride provides services to 4 destinations outside City limits for the convenience of our ridership. These satellite points are:

SPECIAL ASSISTANCE

If you require special assistance, please let us know when you make your reservation. Although all vehicles are equipped with wheelchair lifts, we need to schedule adequate time to accommodate your needs. If you are physically disabled or frail, and need assistance to board the vehicle, you may bring an "escort" to assist you. Drivers cannot act as your escort to or from any building. When you make your reservations, notify the dispatcher that you need two seats. Companions will not be allowed to ride unless they are either eligible for Senior Ride or are serving as an "escort."

GUIDELINES

Senior Ride is a free service and very much in demand. To better assist everyone, follow these simple guidelines:

- Wait outside in front of your pick-up address.

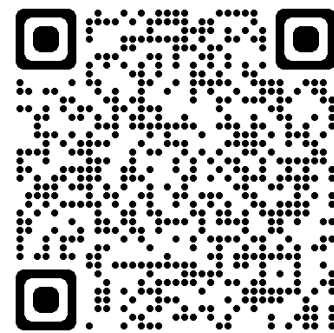

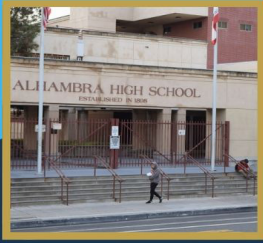

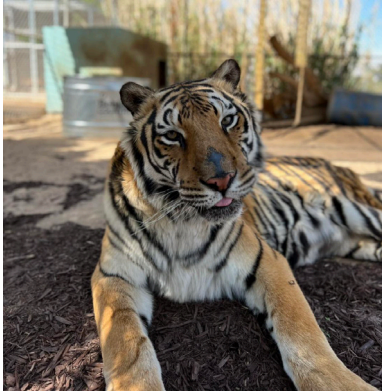
